The primary purpose of the PMBOK Guide is to identify that subset of the Project Management Body of Knowledge that is generally recognized as good practice.

PRINCE2 is a project management method. It is a *structured approach,* which can be tailored for use on any type or size of project.


PMBOK is a *standard*


PRINCE2 is a *method*


The PMBOK Guide is an internationally recognized standard (IEEE Std 1490-2003) that provides the fundamentals of project *management* as they apply to a wide range of projects, including construction, software, engineering, automotive, etc.

PRINCE (PRojects IN Controlled Environments) is a structured method for effective project management. It is a de facto standard used extensively by the UK Government and is widely recognised and used in the private sector, both in the UK and internationally.

PMBOK is - *descriptive* – in explaining project management techniques. PRINCE2 is - prescriptive – in explaining how project management techniques should be structured and applied. PMBOK Guide *is processbased*, meaning it describes work as being accomplished by processes PRINCE2 *is product based*, focus on successful deliveries of projects rather than on the activities of the project. PMBOK: A project is a temporary endeavor undertaken to create a unique product, service, or result PRINCE2: A project is a management environment that is created for the purpose of delivering one or more business products according to a specified business case PMBOK: The Project Manager *is the person responsible* for accomplishing the project objectives PRINCE2: The Project Manager *is given the authority* to run the project on a day-to-day basis *on behalf of the Project Board*.
